The sun-kissed island of Malta is a treasure trove of beautiful beaches, crystal blue seas, and centuries of history, all topped off with that chilled out Mediterranean vibe. Get ready to discover everything this little island with a big personality has to offer! Students stay in a hotel located on the north side of the island, close to beautiful sandy beaches, while studying at St Martin's College, a local school.

Accommodation

Hotel Residence

- Triple or quad rooms with shared bathroom
- Common spaces
- Room furniture includes a wardrobe, TV, and air conditioner
- Rooms cleaned every other day
- Laundry available in residence building at an additional cost
- Dinner and breakfast served at hotel, lunch served at school or activity
- Wi-Fi available in common areas
- Hotels are located within a 30-minute private bus journey from the school

Homestay

- Triple or quad room, shared bathroom, full board
- Laundry facilities will be provided by the family once a week
- Bed linen and towels are provided. Linen and towels will be cleaned once a week by the homestay provider
- Bedrooms and bathrooms will be cleaned once a week by the homestay provider
- Homestay providers are all located within a 30-minute bus journey of the learning centre

Language programme

- Taught by friendly and professional English teachers
- 20 x 45 minute lessons per week morning or afternoon
- Placement test on day 1 to ensure students in appropriate level
- Maximum 15 students per class
- Students will be placed in an international class with students of different nationalities
- Spacious modern classrooms with interactive whiteboards
- Curriculum with emphasis on communication skills
- Materials included as well as end of course report and certificate

Residence facilities

Accommodation

Triple or quad rooms at a local hotel. Each room is nicely furnished with a single bed, wardrobe, TV, air conditioner and Wi-Fi is available in common areas.

Deposit of €50 in some of our hotels

Cleaning

- Rooms are cleaned weekly

Towels

Towels are provided, however students should bring their own beach towels.

Laundry

Dinner and breakfast served at hotel, lunch served at school or activity.

Breakfast

Continental breakfast available including juice, tea, coffee, toast, jams, cereal, pastries and fruit

Lunch

One hot or cold dish and a dessert will be provided either at school or whilst out at activities.

Dinner

Three courses, 2 main course options including a vegetarian option

Packed lunches (provided at weekends)

This will consist of a sandwich, water and a dessert.

Snacks

There are several shops nearby to purchase snacks, drinks and confectionary

Lunch - One hot or cold dish and a dessert will be provided either at school or whilst out at activities. Packed lunches provided by homestays at the weekend.

Programme information

Arrival

Students will be welcomed upon arrival to the hotel residence where they will register and get their room keys so that they can check in to their rooms.

Homestay students will be welcomed by their homestay family.

Welcome

On the first evening there will be a welcome activity which is designed to ensure students have the opportunity to meet staff and other students and get to know more about the centre, its facilities and useful information which will help them during their stay.

Activities

Activities are organised on days when there are no trips and during the evenings, these activities take place either on-site or near the centre. These may include:

- **Sports** such as football, mini Olympics, rounders, table tennis, volleyball and basketball
- **Daytime activities** such as scavenger hunts and drama workshops
- **Evening activities** such as karaoke, talent show and team games

Full-day excursions

Our students get to visit the beautiful island of Comino and explore the best bits of this sparkling jewel.

Half-day trips:

Our students get to explore exciting places around Malta such as Valletta, Mdina, Marsaxlokk and go on a harbour cruise.

All trips that are included are half-days. At weekends, students get to explore the most beautiful beaches around Malta.

Optional excursions

Take advantage of the additional trips that are available from Malta.

Gozo: Full-day excursions to Malta's smaller sister island, full of centuries of history and lots to explore.

Sicily: Full-day excursion to the beautiful Italian island of Sicily, filled with gorgeous landscapes and a mix of cultures.

Beach trips: Optional half-day trips to sandy beaches of Mellieha Bay and Golden Bay.

Sample programmes

Full summer sample programme – Malta

Each 14-night stay will include 8-10 half-day trips around Malta to exciting places such as Valletta, Mdina, Marsaxlokk and harbour cruises. There is also a full-day excursion to the beautiful island of Comino. Additional full-day excursions can be purchased as optional excursions. Transport for trips are done by private buses and chauffeurs.

Student may have lessons either in the morning or in the afternoon in week 1, alternating weekly after that.
