

Embassy Kingswood Royal Holloway

Age range: 10 - 17

Our centre is located on the Kingswood Hall campus of Royal Holloway University of London near the town of Egham, surrounded by beautiful countryside and only 5 miles from Royal Windsor.

The campus is closed and secure, ideal for younger students and offers a mix of single en-suite and standard rooms, as well as a large activity room for communal use.

Accommodation

- Single en-suite and standard rooms available with shared bathroom ratio of around 1:5 students

Language programme

· Taught by friendly and professional English teachers

- \cdot 20 x 45 minute lessons per week morning or afternoon
- \cdot Placement test on day 1 to ensure students in appropriate level
- \cdot Maximum 15 students per class
- · Students will be placed in an international class with students of different nationalities
- · Standard classrooms
- · Curriculum with emphasis on communication skills
- \cdot Materials included as well as an end of course report and certificate









Campus facilities

Accommodation

The accommodation consist of 200 modern, spacious en-suite rooms with shared kitchen pantry and access to a fridge. We also have 100 refurbished standard rooms with wash basin and shared refurbished bathrooms at an approximate ratio of 1:5, all with shared pantry.

Common areas

Our spacious Activity Club is opened daily until 22.30 with sofas, TV and games for students. There is also benches outside in an enclosed green courtyard for socialising and an IT suite available for students to use.

Programme information

Arrival

Coaches arrive by the canteen in the Car Park where groups are met by Centre Staff before being registered and checked into their rooms.

Welcome

On the first evening there will be a welcome activity which is designed to ensure students have the opportunity to meet staff and other students and get to know more about the campus, its facilities and useful information which will help them during their stay.

Activities

Activities are organised every Monday to Friday and every evening all week, for students not on a prepaid excursion or any additional optional trips. These activities could be on-site or near to the centre. These may include:

- **Sports** such as football, mini Olympics, rounders, table tennis, volleyball and basketball
- \cdot Daytime activities such as scavenger hunts and drama workshops
- \cdot $\ensuremath{\text{Evening activities}}$ such as karaoke, talent show and team games

Meals

- Breakfast consist of 3x English Breakfast and 4x Continental per week.
- Lunch and Dinner include a choice of 3 hot meals (one vegetarian) with salad bar, fruit,
- dessert and bread roll.
- \cdot Tea and Coffee available with all meals.
- \cdot Halal option is available.
- · Packed lunches for all full day trips contain sandwich, water, crisps, fruit and cake.
- It's a nut free centre and no foods/snacks with nuts are allowed, very safe for students with allergies.

Onsite Shops

Vending machines offer drinks and snacks. The College run kiosk at reception that are selling refreshments, toiletries and other essential items.

Half-day trips

Our students get to explore exciting places such as Arundel Castle, Windsor Castle and Henley Upon Thames with River Cruise.

Excursions

Students go on two full-day excursions every week. On Tuesdays or Wednesdays they will visit London and explore some of the following:

The Science Museum, The Natural History Museum, The National Gallery, Westminster Walking Tour, The British Museum, Oxford Street shopping and Hyde Park,

At Saturdays students will visit some of the following:

Oxford: explore this iconic university city and get entrance to one of its famous Colleges.

Brighton: enjoy this popular seaside town and visit The Sea Life Centre and The Palace Pier.

Cambridge: visit to this charming university city with walking tour and visit to King's College.

Optional excursions

Thorpe Park: enjoy extreme rides and attractions at this popular theme park

Bath: visit this beautiful, vibrant city known for its ancient Roman Baths. Hampton Court & Richmond upon Thames: beautiful castle next to the river with pretty gardens and visit to the town centre.

Sample programmes

Full summer sample programme - Kingswood

Each 14 night stay will include 2 half-day trips exciting places/cities such as Kew Gardens, Windsor Castle and Henley Upon Thames and 4 full-day excursions to other major cities such as London, Oxford and Brighton. Transport for trips may be by private coach or public transport.

Student may have lessons either in the morning or in the afternoon in week 1, alternating weekly after that.
