

Embassy Malta, St Martin's College

Students will be cared for by our incredible team of teachers and social leaders, with lots of different activities like boat trips, karaoke, treasure hunts and visits to the beach to maximise the fun.

Residence facilities

Accommodation

Multi-bedded dormitory-style rooms, each room is nicely furnished with bunk beds, dressers, and storage cupboards and Wi-Fi is available throughout.

Programme information

Arrival

Students will be welcomed upon arrival to St Martin's College where they will register and get their room keys so that they can check in to their rooms.

Welcome

On the first evening there will be a welcome activity which is designed to ensure students have the opportunity to meet staff and other students and get to know more about the centre, its facilities and useful information which will help them during their stay.

Activities

Activities are organised on days when there are no trips and during the evenings, these activities take place either on-site or near the centre. These may include:

- · **Sports** such as football, mini Olympics, rounders, table tennis, volleyball and basketball
- Daytime activities such as scavenger hunts and drama workshops
- Evening activities such as karaoke, talent show and team games

Half-day trips

Our students get to explore exciting places such as Splash & Fun Water Park, Valletta, sandy beaches, Mdina and the National Aquarium.

Full-day excursions

Full-day excursions in Malta include:

Gozo: our students get to visit Malta's beautiful sister island Gozo and explore the best bits of the island.

South of Malta tour and beach visit: Students visit places like Marsaxlokk, Marsascala and the Blue Grotto as well as cool places to swim.

North of Malta tour and beach visit: Students explore areas with rich cultural heritage and visit gorgeous sandy beaches.

Sliema: Sliema was once an old fishing village but today is one of the main towns in Malta with great shopping, restaurants, cafés and lots to see and do.

Optional excursion

Take advantage of this additional trip that is available from Malta.

Sicily: Full-day excursion to the beautiful Italian island of Sicily, filled with gorgeous landscapes and a mix of cultures.

Sample programmes

Full summer sample programme - Malta

Each 14-night stay will include 8-10 half-day trips around Malta to exciting places such as Valletta, Mdina, sandy beaches and Splash & Fun Water Park. There are also 2 full-day excursions included to Gozo, Sliema and the north or south of the island. Additional full-day excursions can be purchased as optional excursions. Transport for trips are done by private buses and chauffeurs.

Student may have lessons either in the morning or in the afternoon in week 1, alternating weekly after that.
