

Sailing

Make a splash this summer and take to the water for a sailing course.

This programme gives students the opportunity to take advantage of fully qualified and experienced instructors – accredited by the Royal Yachting

Association

Students will take to the water on the English Channel as well as Hove Lagoon. They will learn basic nautical skills and get to sail in a variety of boats. Buoyancy aids are provided.

Students will be awarded RYA level 1 dinghy certificate, or higher depending on their level and boats used.

SAILING KEY FACTS:

- · 15 hours English language tuition per week
- · Sailing 4 days per week, 2 hours per day
- · The club provides buoyancy aids
- Instructor to student ratio is from 1:3 to1:5 depending on the boat
- Students join in the whole school activity hour where they will get a chance to mix with students on other programmes
- · Available at Roedean
